

Champagne Christian Naudé

The Naudé vineyards are in the Champagne sub region called L'Aisne situated at the heart of the Marne Valley and between Reims and Paris. For 5 Generations the Naudé family have been the cultivating these –what are today – 6.5 Ha of Pinot Meunier and Pinot Noir vines.

It was in the 80's that Mnr Naudé broke away from the Epernay based co-operative to press and vinify their own wines.

Today it is Magali & Geofroy Naudé who have taken over the business and who work the vines with a passion with the ingrained family morals of respecting the environment that surrounds them.

Champagne Milan

Founded in 1864 by Jean Milan. Unlike many other vineyards they use solely the Chardonnay grape from the village of Oger. Each cuvée represents therefore a different characteristic of the vineyards vines and soils and in turn shows a different side of this noble grape. Oger is located in the heart of the Cotes des Blancs. The village, due to its chalky soils and the microclimate, created by the hills behind the vineyards is regarded as one of the finest for the noble Chardonnay grape and is thus classed as 100% Grand Cru.

Italy **Daniele Pelassa**

Pelassa is a family owned and operated vineyard located at Montà d'Alba in the Roero zone of Piemonte. For more than 50 years Mario Pelassa together with his wife Maria Teresa Viglione had been producing wine from their vineyard. Ten years ago the Azienda started to sell their wines in North Western Italy. Today, Davide and Daniele, Mario's sons have transformed the cantina into a modern and dynamic operation.

Rigorous selection and cloning of vines amongst new plantings, coupled with major investment in the cantina guarantees the quality of the grapes and the wine produced from them. Production and cultivation is as natural as possible, aiming for the vines to gain the full benefit of the terroir. There is rigorous selection of the grapes at harvest and only the best grapes are used. Both the wine cellars and storage areas are temperature controlled all year round

The objective of the owners is to produce wines which have a close correspondence between the vines, the wines and the terroir. For the last few years the azienda has focussed on the cultivation of the three varieties which are naturally suited to the sandy soil of Roero, Arneis, Nebbiolo and Barbera. This selection, combined with dedication, hard work and love and attention to the details has meant that Pelassa is now known not only in Italy but is found on wine lists around the world.

Have an estate of 6 ha called Els Griñols, just outside Bellmunt del Priorat. The vineyards are primarily pre-phylloxera Garnacha and Cariñena. About 105 years old!! Some of the oldest in Priorat! The vines have roots up to 25 feet deep into sheer rock face and with a yield of just around .25kg per plant or less than 1,600 kgs per hectare.



In 2002 Antonio Rosas brother hired Josep Valiente as his oenologist, and the input was immediate – even in the most challenging years Antonio produces magnificent wines!

One of their secrets... They don't even press the grapes! They macerate, and only use the free run juice!!

Bodegas Casajus

In the village of Quintana Del Pidio, at an altitude of 850m above sea level with vineyards up to 920m. JC Calvo and his wife run this spotless sweet smelling winery. His production is just over 100k bottles from their few hectares of immaculately kept bush vines which average at around 60 years of age. With the assets of bush vine, altitude, experience and obsession with quality they produce a handful of wines that are really a cut above the norm in the region.

Bodegas Fin De Siglo

In 1999 Roberto Martinez decided to break away from the garage style rather rustic wine making methods and founded Bodegas Fin De Siglo. Based in Aribes de Abajo in the Rioja Alta... at an altitude of 550-650m. The red sandy soils are somewhat different to that of other parts of the rioja lending itself to the Granacha variety. In certain places the top soil is only 15cm deep.

Although they have begun consolidating their lands by transferring the growing permits and planting new vines in closer proximity to old.. Their small parcels are somewhat spread out around the outskirts of the village as such adding to the complexity of the wines.

Some 25 years ago unlike many other Robertos father did not disregard and uproot all of their Garnacha variety in preference of the higher yielding Tempranillo. Instead they chose balance over yield and only added a proportion of the same and more importantly continued to plant the original local Granahca variety; sometimes onto American root stock or if a vine had died and had left a gap then by training branches into the soil without severing the child plant from its mother –Morgon method as opposed to Pie Franco.

Castillo de Sajazarra

The grand fortress previously owned by ancestors of Don Diego Lopez, the viceroy of Peru is now a prestigious Rioja winery just south of the Cantabria mountain range at the heights/northern most limits of the Rioja Alta.

Some 40 years ago Alfonso Libano a successful part Basque part Catalan, extremely successful business man purchased the Castle as their family home. Tucked away in the old cellar they discovered a press. Given they were surrounded by vines, Alfonso decided to make his own wine but just for his family and close friends.. From there he was bitten with the wine bug!!

Today their vines are planted at 600 to 700m altitude in a soil type of poor fertility where generally just grain, potatoes, pines and scrubland survive. With just 5% of organic matter and the remaining being of high chalk concentration with a large quantity of stones and boulders. The vines fight to survive against high winds coming from the mountain range to the north snapping of whole branches and local wildlife which cherry pick the sweetest fruit..

Caves Carles Andreu

For as long as living memory has it the Andreu family have cultivated vines and made still wines to sell to the negociants in the Penedes area. In 1990 with this wealth of multi generation experience, the two brothers decided to produce a selection of quality wines (Still and sparkling) under their own brand and it was there that was born Caves Carles Andreu.

The relatively recent man made cellar for ageing their wines -in particular for the secondary fermentation of the Cava- is fantastic! 10m below ground the consistency in temperature (+or-.5 oC) allows them to produce sparkling wines with the densest most consistent mouse I have seen in a sparkling wine, comparable only to that of the TOP prestige Champagnes.


With some of the oldest (80+ years old) Trepata and Parelada Bush vines in the region they have some real treats to offer.. including a very special and unique barrel fermented Rosé Cava 100% from old bush vine Trepata.

Gordonzello

Until the mid 1990's the village of Gordoncillo was lost in the deepest barren depths of the Leon Province. Locals were fleeing to seek wealth in the nearby cities; it was fast becoming a ghost town until one day in 1995 a group of growers got together to convert the remaining scattered vineyards into a profitable, concentrated wine-growing business that would anchor the population in the area.

In April 1995 Gordonzello was established as a public limited company with the support of 101 partners who together contributed their 305 hectares of land.

In 2002 the new winery was born and through this great initiative the Gordoncillo wine growing culture and economy was revived.

Vinedos De Nieva

In the early eighties, a French family came down from the South east of France with a view to start a new life making wines... they arrived in village of Nieva and today are quite happily settled and producing some exquisitely fresh and aromatic wines which are driven by their purity of fruit..

Nieva is somewhat different to the baked planes of Rueda... the journey up the steep slopes resembles that of going to the sea side. Pine trees, sand and pebbles... well actually the pebbles are more like boulders.. quite incredible at an altitude of 842m.. With such altitude it is somewhat self-evident as to why the village is called Nieva (Snow). This altitude and soil type is the essence of what makes these wines so special. So fresh and given the free draining properties of the sandy soil – one that does not allow for the Phylloxera insects to survive – it leaves room for the rare find ungrafted root stock commonly known as ‘Pie Franco’.
